**PCPNDT Awareness Program conducted at Mure Memorial Hospital**

Pradhikaran was the Chief Guest and Adv. Surekha Borkute, was the speaker.

Dr. Vilas Shende, Director, briefed the audience about the zest of the program, and welcomed the Chief Guest and the Speaker with Flower Plants.

Adv. Surekha Borkute, in her speech lauded about the PNDT Act and PCPNDT Act. The PNDT Act was first initiated in the year 1988 and later on implemented as PCPNDT ACT in 1994.

She mainly spoke on the technology for determine sex, it was made for the betterment and to monitor the growth of the child. But this technology was used for negative purposes and due to that the ratio percentage between boy child and girl child was drastically imbalance, which was a problem of great concern. She also aware about the Registration and the Hospital should be registered with Nagpur Municipal Corporation (NMC) and Machine should also be registered.

The Chief Guest Justice Dhanraj Kale, in his speech brought forward the facts and figure of the alarming ratio between Boy & Child birth i.e. in various State of India. **In Kerala against 1000 boys the ratio is 1084, in Tamil Nadu against 1000: 960 and in Pondicherry against 1000 boys:**

**1037.** He also lauded about the punishment in case any Hospital or Doctors is found with the mis-utilization of this technology i.e. fine up to Rs. 10000 to Rs.50,000/- and imprisonment up to 3 to 5 years. The license of the Hospital as well as Doctor can be cancelled.

Dr. Nadeem, Khan, General Superintendent, in speech said this is the only program which was implemented on the higher percentage of success.

Doctors, Staff, Student were gathered in large numbers and were benefited immensely out of this informative program.
