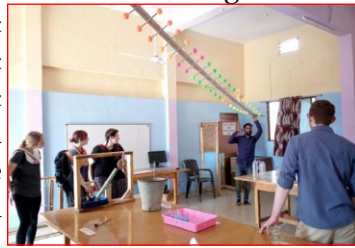
NEWS FOR THE MONTH OF MARCH - 2018
